1.	Participants to complete Rules of Netball Theory Examination (link below) prior to attending workshop. http://netball.com.au/get-involved/umpiring/accreditation/rules-of- netball-theory-examination/ Require 70% or more to pass (valid for 4 years)	Beginner	Print out Certificate and submit a copy to the office prior to the Workshop.
2.	Attend the Beginner Umpire Workshop (with Umpire Educators)	Beginner	Cost \$30 - includes Rules of Netball 2018 & whistle Registration submitted by club
3.	At the conclusion of the workshop, the Umpire Educator will complete an assessment form Level Achieved – participant is a Junior B Umpire. Level Not Achieved – participant to receive additional mentoring. Participants may umpire NetSetGo – White if assessed as competent. Participants may umpire Divisional if assessed as competent. All games will be allocated by the Umpire Allocations Officer	Junior B Beginner/ Mentoring	Beginners will be mentored.
